
#### Greetings everyone!

Some key actions from this group included surveying, assessing and facilitating assistance to those in need from our community as well as launching the new NCWHL Community Board to empower direct conversations and connections between community members. Examples of assistance to date include providing a ride to the airport, writing up a summary of resources on managing insomnia, and supplying mental health treatment referrals.




















































#### COMMUNITY CONVOS (continued)

#### RETURN TO PLAY

On July 22nd, the Board held a discussion as part of the Community Convos Series about return-to-play scenarios. Right now, organized adult recreational hockey is not permitted by the county of San Mateo nor the State of California. As soon as either governing body allows indoor recreational sports and once Nazareth Ice Oasis' return to play plans are approved by said group, we'll notify the league of Registration being opened. Once available, the waiver and list of NCWHL expectations for playing will be shared via the NCWHL Weekly and posted on our website (www.ncwhl.com). We'll aim to have this ready prior to Registration opening so that you can make the most informed decision possible about playing. Once we have the latest rules of operation for the facility (i.e. Nazareth Ice Oasis) we'll also share that in the Weekly and on the website. As a reminder, the playing format will be an 8 vs. 8 pick-up style scrimmage.
